PBA will begin remote instruction starting Monday, March 30. In support of that, we want to make you aware of Spectrum's offer of free internet for the next 60 days. This offer is available to K-12 students as well as college students.

To ease the strain in this challenging time, beginning Monday, March 16, Charter (Spectrum's parent company) commits to the following for 60 days:

- Charter will offer free Spectrum broadband and Wi-Fi access for 60 days to households with K-12 and/or college students who do not already have a Spectrum broadband subscription and at any service level up to 100 Mbps.
- To enroll call **1-844-488-8395**. Installation fees will be waived for new student households.
- Charter will partner with school districts to ensure local communities are aware of these tools to help students learn remotely. Charter will continue to offer Spectrum Internet Assist, high speed broadband program to eligible low-income households delivering speeds of 30 Mbps.
- Charter will open its Wi-Fi hotspots across our footprint for public use.
- Spectrum does not have data caps or hidden fees.
