PBA Application Process: Education House Bill, HB 7029

Bill in effect beginning August 2017

As stated per Patricia Levesque, executive director of the Foundation for Florida's Future, "This legislation removes district boundary lines as barriers blocking students from attending public schools that best meet their needs." The new school must have room, parents must provide transportation and the student must not be under an expulsion or suspension order.

As a charter school, Palm Bay Academy's application process has not changed. We are not bound by school zone or district boundaries concerning student enrollment.

- 1. Obtain a registration packet
- 2. Return original registration packet, completely filled out with the following required attachments...

Re-enrollment From Within County	New Enrollment or Enrollment from Outside County
Latest report card	Original physical dated within 11 months of beginning of school
Tier 1 and tier 2 proof of residencies	Original up to date immunizations
	Copy of birth certificate
	Latest report card
	Tier 1 and tier 2 proof of residencies

- 3. If space is available, student can be enrolled. If there is no space, parents/guardians can request to be put on a wait list for that grade level.
- 4. If space becomes available during the school year, students on the wait list can be enrolled.
- 5. Wait listed registration packets do not roll over to the next school year. A new registration packet must be completed accompanied by the required attachments listed above.
